

6th BTV: Meeting Locations and Final Notes

We have a great program arranged for the 6th BTV and look forward to hosting you in Sydney and Cairns. This memo provides some final notes on meeting locations and logistics for the days ahead.

For participants arriving early, we have included details regarding a casual pre-BTV dinner on Thursday June 14th. This dinner will include participants from the YPCom Board and is an opportunity to meet up (at your own expense) prior to the official events.

June 14th from 18.00 – Casual Pre-BTV Dinner and Drinks, Manly Beach NSW: All are welcome to meet at The Manly Wharf Bar from 1800. The Manly Wharf Bar is located in Manly Beach (a 30 min ferry ride from downtown Sydney). Upon disembarking from the ferry, head right (east). June 15th at 9.00 – Day 1 of the 6th BTV, Sydney NSW: We will be meeting at the Overseas Passenger Terminal near The Rocks in downtown Sydney to commence our harbour tour at 9.00. Please aim to arrive by 845. We will be meeting at the southern end of the Terminal near the Cruise Bar (marked on map below). This is directly across the water from the Opera House. Please ensure you wear warm and comfortable clothes/flat shoes as we will be outside for the entire day. Please contact me if you are likely to be delayed.





June 18th at 1730 – Welcome Reception for the 6th BTV and AGA, Cairns QLD: The Welcome Drinks will be held at the Waterfront Terrace of the Hilton Hotel in Cairns.

June 19th from 845 – Technical Presentations of the 6th BTV, Cairns QLD: The technical presentations will be held at Hilton Hotel Cairns. A separate memo has been provided with the program details. The presentations will conclude at 17.00. The Gala Dinner will be held at the Cairns Cruise Liner Terminal from 19.00.

June 20th at 7.00 – Technical Tour, Cairns QLD: The technical tour will depart from the Reef Fleet Terminal in Cairns at 7.00. The Reef Fleet Terminal and the Hilton Hotel are both marked on the map of Cairns below.





Final Notes:

Clothing: Please note that it is winter in Sydney (10 – 18⁰C) and appropriate warm weather clothing is required. A rain jacket maybe required for the outdoor excursions. Cairns will be warmer with temperatures ranging from 18 – 25⁰C.

Transport in Sydney: An OPAL card is required to access public transport in Sydney. OPAL cards can be purchased from many locations, including the airport train station. They are valid on all forms of transport (tap the OPAL machine when you get on/off) as long as the card has sufficient funds preloaded.
